

Our pupils wear their uniform with pride.

School Uniform

- Grey trousers/shorts or skirt/pinafore dress
- White shirt or blouse with red tie (tie may be elasticated) or white polo shirt
- Red sweatshirt or cardigan
- Optional red fleece
- Black Shoes (trainers are not acceptable)
- During the Summer months girls may wear red checked dresses and sandals.

P.E. Kit

- White T-shirt or polo shirt
- Red shorts
- Grey or red tracksuits/jogging bottoms and school fleeces - cold weather
- Black pumps - elasticated for younger children (Trainers may be worn instead of pumps)
- Football boots and shin-pads may be worn for football.

Forestry School Kit

- Warm, old clothing- any colour
- Waterproof coat and, if possible, waterproof trousers
- Wellies with a spare pair of warm socks
- Gloves
- Hat.

Waterproof jackets, hats and bags are also available from both suppliers.

Please remember to mark EVERY item of clothing with your

child's name and then we will be able to re-unite them with mislaid items

Jewellery

- Items of jewellery can cause accidents so we do not allow children to wear jewellery in any kind of physical activity e.g. games, P.E., swimming.
- Earrings left in for P.E. need to be covered with sticking plasters.
- Watches must be removed but children must be responsible for their own things.

Hairstyles

- Hair must be of natural colouring and in an appropriate style for school.
- We do not permit tram-lines etc.
- Long hair should be tied-back/ plaited etc. (School will decide if a style is appropriate).
- Swimming in years 3 to 6 - Costume/trunks/shorts (not knee-length shorts), towel, cap (compulsory). Goggles may be worn. A little talc put in the cap at home helps your child to put their own cap on.

P.E./ Swimming/Forestry Kits' Storage

- P.E. kit - kept in a drawstring bag marked with your child's name. This is kept in school and sent home to be washed every half term.
- Forestry Kit - kept in a drawstring bag marked with your child's name. To be brought in weekly by Ladybirds, Butterflies, Busy Bees and Eager Beavers.
- Swimming Kit - kept in a drawstring bag marked with your child's name. Brought in weekly when needed.
