The system will go live over the summer holidays once all year groups have rolled up on the internal admin system. You will all receive a PIN to be able to set up an account linked to your child/children. We are hoping that once up and running this new system will make it a lot easier for parents to book and pay for activities/ sessions. Obviously, with any new system we expect teething problems so please so bear with us as we get the system up and running any issues ironed out. Thank you.

On Thursday evening, our Year 6 pupils that have been working on their Junior Rotary Award throughout the year, attended the Civic Hall for a presentation evening. The children that completed the award have all worked incredibly hard throughout the year completing community service, physical recreation, learning new skills and experiencing a range of cultural events. They have also each pulled together a portfolio showcasing all of their work for the award. Well done to all of the children that achieved this amazing award.


